Water temperature is below 60 degrees and the visibility is exceptional at 40 feet. Several windy days have played havoc with fishing conditions, but the dry conditions this winter often make for a beautiful few days after each wind event.

Take the tag to the LMVA Sales Office where you can redeem the tag for a prize. Prizes include Line, bait packs, free rental boats, Trout Kits, Reels and Shimano Rod/Reel combos.

Please weigh your fish and tell the Sales Clerk your name and the weight of your tagged trout.
